- Step 1: Cut out a circular lid on your pumpkin and scoop out the innards. You may keep the pulp or seeds for baking!
- Step 2: Secure the stencil on your pumpkin by taping around the edges of the paper.
- Step 3: Carefully carve the dark portions of the stencil and remove the loose pieces of pumpkin.
